The Steps Program is the Environment Institute of Australia and New Zealand's (EIANZ) training program for early career practitioners.

Aligned with the Institute's mission to lead excellence in environmental practice, the Steps Program plays an integral role in building the knowledge and skills of environmental professionals, providing a pathway to skilled and ethical practice and potential certification

Events have been designed by leading environmental practitioners and experienced training providers. Each event combines theoretical knowledge and real life case studies or presentations by industry professionals, providing practical skills which can be directly applied in the workplace.

Environmental Ethics

The ethical practice of environmental management is among the qualities that sets EIANZ members apart in the field and is a founding value of the Institute. This event provides participants with an introduction to the principles and practice of environmental ethics with a view to embedding quality principles at an early stage of a career. Delivered by industry professionals, the workshop equips participants with practical strategies for dealing with likely challenges and issues faced by early professionals around environmental ethics.

Participants will:

- + Explore the principles of environmental ethics standards, history, trends and Australian and international standards
- + Understand the purpose of the focus on ethics by the Institute, its relationship to your career and potential certification as an Environmental Practitioner
- + Examine real life examples; challenges and strategies for early professionals; developing a personal decision making framework
