## **4WD ECO TOUR**

On this beautiful day out off-roading, you'll visit Fraser Island's top natural attractions and cool off in watering holes - and all in the air-conditioned comfort of Kingfisher Bay Resort's custom-designed, four-wheel-drive coaches. Your ranger guide will give you as much or as little interpretive information on the cultural and human history of the island, hunt out bush tucker, tell you how plants survive in the sand and much more.

# **BUSH TUCKER TALK AND TASTE**

Learn about Australian cuisine - it will change your ideas on food preparation. As Australia develops its own cuisine, the natural bush food that is growing all around us is becoming increasingly popular.

Find out how bush foods can be used to enhance most dishes as rangers present a selection of foods in their natural, raw state and explain where you can find these foods. Your chef will present cooked dishes for you to taste and share some recipe secrets.

#### **DINNER AT SEABELLE**

When the day's exploring is done, it's time to take the tastebuds on a voyage of their own in Kingfisher Bay Resort's signature Seabelle Restaurant.

The Chef de Cuisine has drawn inspiration from Fraser Island's indigenous Butchulla tribe - crafting his menus to blend seasonal, local produce, fresh seafood, Australian bush tucker and island living. This is a place where herbs and garnishes are home-grown at the resort's nursery, and delivered fresh by the resort's gardeners to the kitchen door.

# WATCH THE SUNSET FROM THE JETTY

Fish feed and dart amongst the jetty piles, dingoes lope along the beach and as the sun dips, the Jetty Hut is perfect to perch for great views and lively conversation.

Keep your eyes peeled for holidaying whales that visit Fraser Island from time-to-time, you'll spot them from the end of the jetty - it's magic!

Enjoy the sunset with a cheese platter and an afternoon beverage (additional drinks available for purchase if required)
