### About the speaker – Dr Tom Hatton



Tom started as Chair of the WA Environmental Protection Authority in 2015 having served on the Board since 2014. He is on the Board of the International Centre for Radio Astronomy Research and advisory panels for the Department of Water as well as the UWA Oceans Institute, where he is an Adjunct Professor. He recently completed appointments on the Australian Government's Independent Expert Scientific Committee on Coal Seam Gas and Large Coal Mining Development, and as Chair of the Western Australian Marine Parks and Reserve Authority. Dr Hatton retired as CSIRO's Group Executive for Energy in 2014, where he previously directed national water and marine research programs. In 2008, Tom received the CSIRO Chairman's medal and the Australian Public Service Medal for his contributions to the management of Australia's waste resources. Tom completed his BSc and MSc degrees at Humboldt State University and his PhD at Utah State University, followed by a post-doctoral appointment in the Mathematics Department of the UNSW (ADFA).
