An engaging analysis of the politics surrounding the nuclear storage debate in South Australia.

HAYDON MANNING

Associated Professor Haydon Manning teaches and researches contemporary Australian political issues at Flinders University. A frequent commentator on State and national politics his main research interests focus on political attitudes, voting behavior, elections, political parties, and energy policy debates.

Recent research publications analyse how the Liberal and Labor campaign strategists plot to win over the swinging voters, the politics of uranium mining in Australia, the 2014 SA State Election and political cartooning during the 2013 national election.

He teaches a large first level class introducing students to Australian politics and government, and upper level topics covering political and economic history, electoral behavior and environmental politics. He is also the Flinders University convenor of the Joint South Australian universities, SA Parliamentary Internship program.
