

By-law 9

9. HONORARY LIFE MEMBERSHIP

9.1 General

Honorary Life Membership may be conferred on a person in recognition of outstanding service to the Institute. Such service may be given to the Institute as a whole or to any of its Chapters or Divisions. It is expected that such service would be exceptional in terms of effort over an extended period and in terms of influencing the development of the Institute.

9.2 Nomination and appointment procedure

- (1) Nominations for Honorary Life Membership may be made by Divisions or Chapters or by the Executive Committee. Such nomination must be accompanied by a detailed documentation of the services contributed to the Institute and an explanation of the significance of this contribution in the development of the Institute.
- (2) Nominations shall be reviewed by the Council, which shall determine whether the nominee should be appointed as an Honorary Life Member.
- (3) The appointment of an Honorary Life Member should be formally announced at an appropriate public occasion such as the Annual Conference or the Annual General Meeting.
- (4) Until the time of the public announcement, all deliberations with respect to nomination and appointment of Honorary Life Members shall be confidential among those involved in this process.
