WHAT IS THE BACHELOR OF ENVIRONMENTS?

THE COURSE TAKES A UNIQUE, MULTIDISCIPLINARY APPROACH TO THE STUDY OF OUR ENVIRONMENT. RECOGNISING THE COMPLEX RELATIONSHIPS BETWEEN OUR LANDSCAPES AND OUR CITIES, IT EXAMINES HOW THE NATURAL, VIRTUAL, BUILT AND SOCIAL WORLDS HAVE SUSTAINED OUR PAST AND DEFINE OUR FUTURE.

The B.Envs is one of The University of Melbourne's new generation degrees. It is a three-year undergraduate degree that combines science, technology, design and the social sciences.

Students have the choice of 11 majors:

- Architecture
- Landscape Architecture
- Urban Design and Planning
- Civil Systems (Civil Engineering)
- Construction
- Environmental Geographies, Politics and Cultures
- Environmental Science
- Geomatics
- Landscape Management
- Physical Systems (Environmental Engineering)
- Property

The process of specialisation prepares students for graduate study in the chosen field whilst promoting interdisciplinary approaches to learning. Students complete electives from across the 11 majors alongside the core subjects for their chosen major. Students also complete one subject each semester from outside the degree itself which is known as 'breadth' and cannot be related to core studies. This means that the students and graduates of the degree are equipped with a much more comprehensive understanding of the range of issues affecting the 11 major areas. It also enables them to choose other studies complementary to their degree in other ways such as language, climate change studies, politics, sociology, marketing, teaching, etc.

WHAT IS ENVI?

Envi. is the student run society for students of the Bachelor of Environments no matter what their major of study may be. Born from the Melbourne Model, Envi. is one of the newest student societies at the University of Melbourne and is now in its third year of operation. The society is charged with bringing together students from across the 11 majors and three years students to achieve.

As the degree grows so is Envi. and this year the committee is organising the first interdisciplinary Industry Night for BEnvs undergraduates.

Envi. recognises that the unique interdisciplinary nature of the degree provides new opportunities for students, graduates and perspective employers, and intends to bring them all to one place.

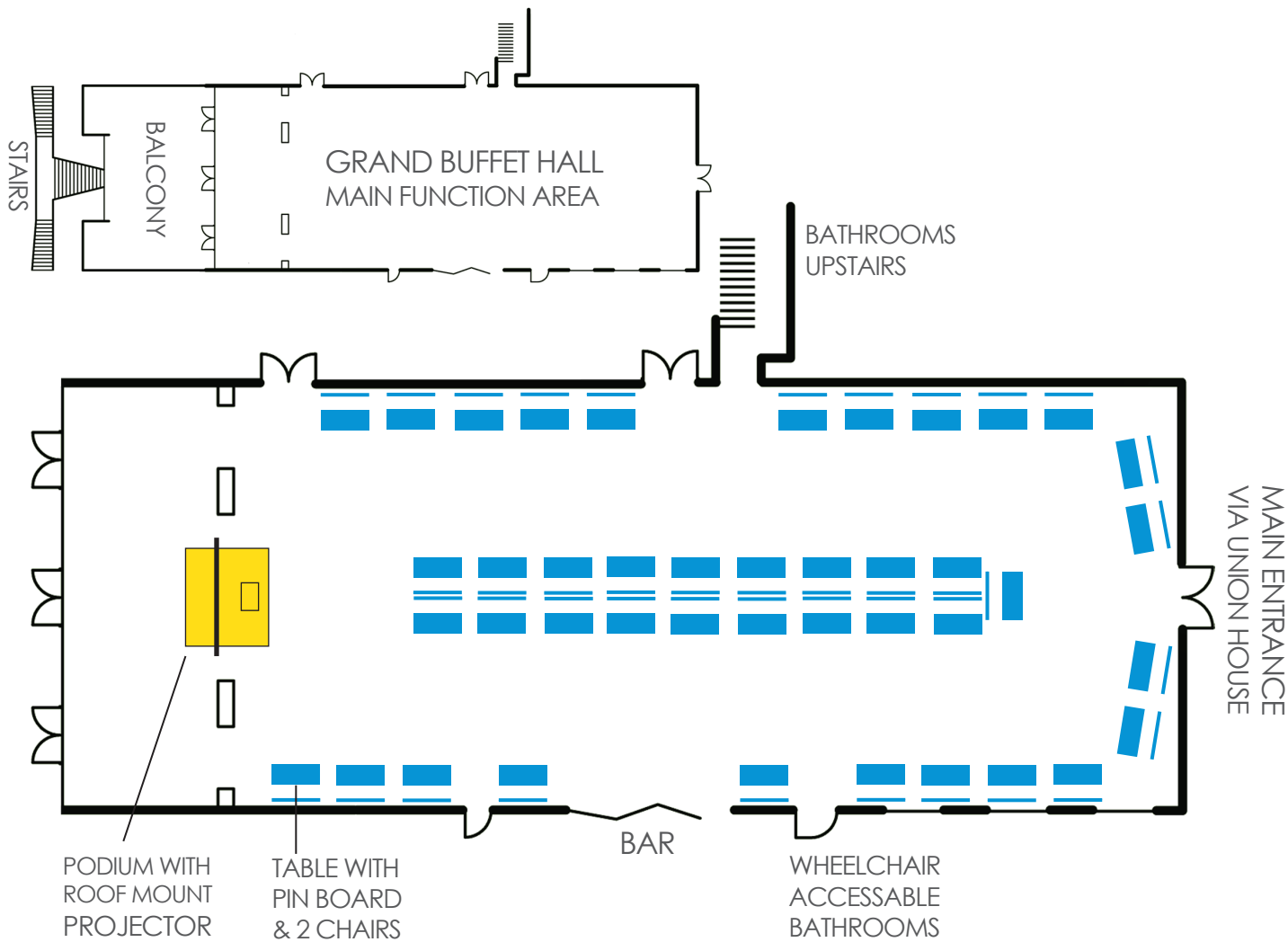
DON'T MISS THE OPPORTUNITY TO MEET THE NEW FACE OF AUSTRALIAN EDUCATION
