


- Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999
- Part 3 protects 8 matters of National Environmental Significance
- Remediation Determination,
 Enforceable Undertakings,
 Conservation Agreements, civil and criminal sanctions
- ■Big fines, up to \$5.5M or 7 years in prison

- ■8 Enforceable Undertakings in the past 20 months
- 2 Remediation Determinations
- \$2,771,010 directed to protection of the matter impacted
- guarantees of future offsets valued at over \$4.5M
- ■Injunction under S475









Avoiding impacts and compliance actions




- Plan ahead
