Recent policy change

- Flying-fox Camp Management Policy 2015:** Issued by the Office of Environment & Heritage, NSW.

First National Flying-fox Symposium Brisbane August 1986

- Focussed on impacts to fruit growers
- Called for:
 - Effective control measures
 - Understanding of national populations, location of camps and movements
 - Benefit of flying-foxes in the maintenance of native flora to be quantified
 - A handbook outlining flying-fox control techniques
 - **A separate national unit to drive coordination of research, conservation and management**

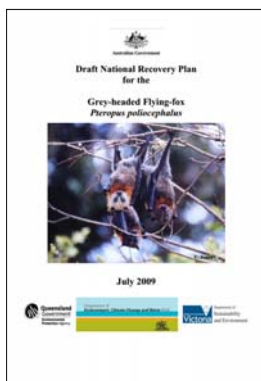

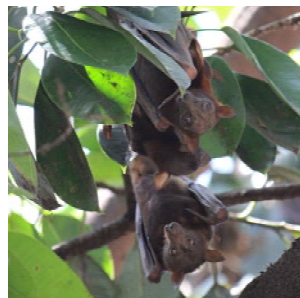
