









ABOUT

The Australasian Network for Ecology and Transportation (ANET) is a professional network dedicated to the research, design and implementation of environmentally-sensitive linear infrastructure (rail, roads and utility easements) across Australasia. ANET acts as a hub, providing links between government, industry, scientists and community groups to ensure all have access to current evidence and best practice.

ANET have held International conferences in Brisbane (2009) and Coffs Harbour (2014). ANET conferences focus on disseminating global best practice in identifying and mitigating the ecological impacts of all types of linear infrastructure and transport, including road, rail, pipelines and utility easements.

The 2018 conference in Victoria will focus on the intersection of people and linear infrastructure, specifically how both people and nature are connected along, across and between different types of infrastructure. In 2018 ANET will be co-hosted by the Environment Institute of Australia and New Zealand (EIANZ) to deliver this premier event, with generous support from our principal sponsor VicRoads.

Linear Infrastructure and vehicles present what is an essentially wicked problem – we need safe and efficient transport networks to move people, goods and resources such as power, water, gas and data. However, at the same time, these networks can impose significant impacts on biodiversity and ecosystem services, such as wildlife-vehicle collision with injury and loss of life to people and wildlife, habitat loss and degradation, weed invasion, and noise, light and chemical pollution.

The theme for 2018 is Connecting Nature, Connecting People, and will explore the nexus between our reliance on linear infrastructure to support economic growth and quality of life, the significant challenges we face to create an ecologically sustainable infrastructure network and the opportunities that new technology, research and practice provides.

Following on from the hugely successful 2009 and 2014 conferences, the 2018 gathering will include two days of presentations, plenary lectures, workshops and networking opportunities, with a field trip on the third day.

CONFERENCE THEMES

Most major road, rail and other linear infrastructure projects in Australia face ecological and environmental issues. Often there is a legislative and social imperative to ensure these issues are considered.

For many projects there is still uncertainty about:

- The full extent of the potential impact
- The effectiveness of different mitigation options
- The cost-effectiveness of different potential alignments or mitigation options.

This conference is an important step toward increasing collaboration among researchers, agencies, all levels of government, environmental practitioners, engineers, planners and construction teams to ensure mitigation of road and linear infrastructure networks are cost effective, ecologically sustainable and safe for all users.

It presents an opportunity to set future directions in the management of linear infrastructure and mitigation measures and to define the future of transportation and ecology.



The Connecting Nature, Connecting People conference aims to:

- Increase awareness of the impacts of all types of linear infrastructure, the mitigation options currently used and their effectiveness for wildlife, plants and ecosystems.
- Provide an opportunity for collaboration and discussion among stakeholders including researchers, government road agencies, policy makers, planners, construction companies, ecological consultants and landscape architects.
- Inform attendees of the advances in mitigation measures in Australia and showcase projects and structures in Victoria.
- Update attendees about the latest developments globally, with representatives from North and South America, Asia and Europe who are leading the world in innovative and cost-effective approaches to reducing the ecological impacts of roads, traffic and other linear infrastructure, as well as the many challenges facing developing countries globally.
- Set a standard for future design of infrastructure networks and mitigation measures in Australasia.

VENUE

The conference will be held at the <u>RACV Goldfields Resort, Creswick, Victoria</u>, just out of Ballarat and about one hours' drive from Melbourne.

The venue has modern facilities, including an integrated space for trade and sponsor displays and lunches and morning and afternoon breaks, ensuring maximum exposure for sponsors. Accommodation is provided on-site, ensuring delegates will have ample opportunity to engage with the sponsors and trade displays throughout the conference.


