In accordance with the EIANZ's **Rules of Association** and **By-Law 6**, arrangements have been made with Australian Election Company to conduct the 2021 Elections for the Board of the Environment Institute of Australia and New Zealand Inc., using online voting. Nominations are now invited to fill the seven positions on the EIANZ Board:

- Vice-President (Australia)
- Vice-President (New Zealand)
- Secretary
- Treasurer
- 2 Ordinary Board Members

To be eligible for Nomination, you must be a current financial Ordinary (Full) Member, Fellow Member, Honorary Fellow Member or Honorary Life Member of the Environment Institute of Australia and New Zealand Inc. The two Members or Fellows endorsing the Nomination must also be current financial members. Associate Members or Student Members are not eligible to vote and cannot endorse nominations.

- be signed by the endorser number 1 (who must be a current financial member as defined above)
- be signed by the endorser number 2 (who must be a current financial member as defined above).
