ABOUT Geoff Mills

Geoff has previously spent many years undertaking various roles on the Gawler Ranges Soil Conservation Board, The Rangelands Soil Board Executive and the South Australian Arid lands NRM Board.

He is a pastoral lessee, owner/manager of pastoral land in the southern rangelands, pasturing a small flock of merino sheep primarily for wool production. As the Environment Assurance Manager for Arrium Mining he is responsible for collecting baseline environmental data and developing outcomes and measurement criteria for tenement proposals and PEPR approvals for mine development and operation.

Geoff is also a presiding member of the Pastoral Board of South Australia. The Pastoral Board has responsibility to administer the Pastoral Act, to ensure that the pastoral lands are well managed and yield sustained, monitor the condition of the lands, prevent degradation of the lands and native vegetation, provide a form of tenure that is conducive to the economic viability of the pastoral industry, recognise the right of Aboriginal persons to follow traditional pursuits on those lands and provide to the community a system of access to and through those lands.

Geoff will be presenting on the flora and fauna of the Middleback Ranges and Peculiar Knob with some insights into gaining and maintaining the environmental and social licence to operate a modern mine site.
