The Nature Conservation Act is Queensland's principal piece of conservation legislation and has been operating for over 24 years. Although there has been some tinkering around the edges, notably to the changes to protected plants in 2013, the Act remains much the same as it was when enacted in 1992. Reform has been on the agenda for some time, but this seminar is an opportunity to put forward a wish list of changes that practitioners, local government officers, project managers and others would like to see in future amendments.

Some particular areas of concern include:

- The operation of the new protected plants framework and survey guidelines;
- How high risk areas are mapped and updated with new records;
- Management of threatened species and their habitat;
- Species management programs;
- Licensing, permits and approvals

This forum explores:

- The current regimes for protection and management of wildlife under the NC Act.
- Opportunities for improvement or efficiencies within the established frameworks.
- An example from other jurisdictions.
- Developing a wish list for the NC Act.
