Western Australia is undergoing significant environmental regulatory reform. In 2013, the Department of Environment Regulation (DER) was established as a standalone environmental regulator. In 2014 the DER embarked on a program to make environmental regulation in Western Australia more efficient, effective, transparent, consistent and accountable by developing a comprehensive risk-based approach to its regulatory functions under Part V Division 3 of the Environmental Protection Act 1986.
