Western Australia's biodiversity offsetting framework presents opportunities for improvement to enhance conservation outcomes. Operating under Parts IV and V of the Environmental Protection Act, the current system would benefit from greater coordination between regulatory pathways and more systematic tracking of offset effectiveness. As a global biodiversity hotspot facing pressures including historical vegetation clearing in the Wheatbelt, Western Australia is well-positioned to lead innovative offsetting approaches.

This one day forum harnesses WA's community of practitioners to explore a critical question: 'How do we make offsetting more effective in delivering improved biodiversity outcomes?'. The forum will workshop practical solutions and develop collaborative proposals for the WA Government to enhance offsetting as a conservation tool.
